
The conditions of the award are: (1) that Ethics Board approval for your research must be received and submitted to the HRI by 30 September 2023; (2) that you present your research findings at the HRI Research Showcase in April 2024; (3) that by June 30th, 2024 you will prepare and submit a narrative report of the project that will be published on the HRI website, as part of a forthcoming "working papers" series; (4) that you engage in an interview for the preparation of an episode of the *Let's Talk Research!*, the HRI Podcast series, and (5) that you become an active member of the HRI Advisory Board for the tenure of your fellowship (July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024).

Once the REB approval letter is submitted to the HRI Director, funds will be disbursed into an account set up for this project by Financial Services. You will have until June 30, 2024 to make use of these funds.

In order to recognize your HRI Fellowship, the title, brief description of the project, and a photo of you will be posted to the HRI website and on our various social media.
